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2	The purpose of this Act is to protect farmers and
3	landowners from national efforts to site electric trans-
4	mission facilities over the objection of State regulators.
5	SEC. 3. SITING OF INTERSTATE ELECTRIC TRANSMISSION

7	(a) In General.—Section 216(b) of the Federal
8	Power Act (16 U.S.C. 824p(b)) is amended—
9	(1) by striking paragraph (1) and inserting the
10	following:
11	"(A) a State in which the transmission fa-
12	cilities are to be constructed or modified does
13	not have authority to approve the siting of the
14	facilities;";
15	(2) by redesignating paragraphs (2) through
16	(6) as subparagraphs (B) through (F), respectively,
17	and indenting appropriately;
18	(3) in the matter preceding subparagraph (A)
19	(as so designated), by striking "Except" and insert-
20	ing the following:
21	"(1) In general.—Except";
22	(4) in paragraph (1) (as so designated)—
23	(A) in subparagraph (E), by striking
24	"and" at the end;
25	(B) in subparagraph (F), by striking the
26	period at the end and inserting "; and"; and

1	(C) by adding at the end the following:
2	"(G) the proposed construction or modi-
3	fication minimizes any adverse effects on land-
4	owners and agriculture, adequately compensates

16	substantially similar application; or
17	"(B) is currently reviewing an identical or
18	substantially similar application.".
19	(b) Conforming Amendment.—Section 216(i)(4)
20	of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 824p(i)(4)) is
21	amended by striking ", unless" in the matter preceding
22	subparagraph (A) and all that follows through the period
23	at the end of subparagraph (B) and inserting a period.
24	SEC. 4. REPORT.
25	(a) Definitions.—In this section:

1	(1) Commission.—The term "Commission"
2	means the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.
3	(2) COMMITTEES OF JURISDICTION.—The term
4	"committees of jurisdiction" means—
5	(A) the Committee on Energy and Natural
6	Resources of the Senate; and
7	(B) the Committee on Energy and Com-
8	merce of the House of Representatives.
9	(b) REPORT REQUIRED.—Not later than 1 year after
10	the date of enactment of this Act, and annually thereafter,
11	the Commission shall submit to the committees of jurisdic-
12	tion and make publicly available a report describing all
13	actions taken by the Commission pursuant to section
14	216(b) of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 824p(b)) dur-
15	ing the period covered by the report.
16	(c) Contents.—The report required under sub-
17	section (b) shall include a description of—
18	(1) any adverse effects on private landowners,
19	farmers, and agricultural producers;
20	(2) how those effects were taken into account;
21	and
22	(3) the steps taken by the Commission—
23	(A) to minimize those effects;
24	(B) to compensate any affected individuals;
