To amend the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 to provide for increases in the minimum wage, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Higher Wages for
- 5 American Workers Act of 2025".
- 6 SEC. 2. MINIMUM WAGE INCREASE.
- 7 (a) In General.—Section 6(a)(1) of the Fair Labor
- 8 Standards Act of 1938 (29 U.S.C. 206(a)(1)) is amended
- 9 to read as follows:

1	"(1) except as otherwise provided in this sec-

3	"(A) \$15, beginning on January 1 of the

12	(b) Annual Change Based on Inflation.—Sec-

- "(A) the amount in effect under subsection 1 2 (a)(1) on the date of such determination increased 3 by the percentage increase, if any, in the Consumer 4 Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical 5 Workers (or a successor index), as published by the 6 Bureau of Labor Statistics, for the 12-month period 7 ending with July of the year in which the determina-8 tion occurs; and 9 "(B) rounded to the nearest multiple of \$0.05, 10 if the amount after applying subparagraph (A) is 11 not a multiple of \$0.05.". 12 SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 13 This Act and the amendments made by this Act shall 14 take effect on January 1 of the first year that begins after the date of enactment of this Act.
