A BILL

To amend title 9, United States Code, with respect to arbitration of disputes involving human trafficking.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ARBITRATION OF DISPUTES INVOLVING**
4 **HUMAN TRAFFICKING.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 4 of title 9, United
6 States Code, is amended—

7 (1) in the heading, by striking “**ASSAULT**
8 **AND SEXUAL HARASSMENT**” and inserting
9 “**ASSAULT, SEXUAL HARASSMENT, AND**
10 **HUMAN TRAFFICKING**”;

1 (2) in section 401—

2 (A) by redesignating paragraphs (1)
3 through (4) as paragraphs (2) through (5), re-
4 spectively; and

5 (B) by inserting before paragraph (2), as
6 so redesignated, the following:

7 “(1) HUMAN TRAFFICKING DISPUTE.—The
8 term ‘human trafficking dispute’ means a dispute
9 relating to conduct prohibited by—

10 “(A) chapter 77 of title 18; or

11 “(B) Tribal or State laws prohibiting
12 human trafficking.”; and

13 (3) in section 402(a)—

14 (A) by striking “dispute or sexual assault
15 dispute” and inserting “dispute, sexual assault
16 dispute, or human trafficking dispute”; and

17 (B) by striking “dispute or the sexual har-
18 assment dispute” and inserting “dispute, sexual
19 harassment dispute, or human trafficking dis-
20 pute”.

21 (b) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—

22 The table of chapters for title 9, United States Code, is
23 amended by striking the item relating to chapter 4 and
24 inserting the following:

**“4. Arbitration of disputes involving sexual assault, sex-
ual harassment, and human trafficking 401.”.**
